Fortunately, they never lost hope and nor will they. They also say, some used to consider it The Switzerland of the Middle East.




I shall keep an unforgettable memory of this country that welcomed me for more than two months."








"The beneficial effect of money", © 2016 7 000 bills of Lebanese lira











"And now let's let the time fill our hearts", © 2016 Wood, rope and bullets; variable dimensions













"Fuck my way up to the top", © 2016 Wood and mirror; 80 x 110 cm
